



# Western Bean Cutworm Trap Network Information Sheet

## Creating a Profile, Adding a Trap and Submitting Counts Online


### Step 1: Creating a profile

#### From a computer:

Using your computer, tablet, iPad or cell phone, go to [www.cornpest.ca](http://www.cornpest.ca) and click on the “Login” menu from the top left of the page (on a computer) or from the top right of the page (using a mobile device). Latitude and Longitude values MUST be in **decimal degree format**. (Degrees, minutes, seconds can be converted to decimal degrees here: <http://www.latlong.net/degrees-minutes-seconds-to-decimal-degrees> )

Each trap site must be added and reported separately. If, for example, you have 25 traps, you will need to "add a trap" for each of the 25 traps. Once your trap(s) is added, you can begin to report your moth catches.

Save Counts

Enter your WBC moth counts once a week, preferably on the following Monday and no later than the Wednesday of each week. This is our cut off to sending data in for mapping. You may need to check your traps more often during peak flight. If this is the case, keep a running tally of your catches and report the number once. You cannot report trap counts more than once a week. If you make an error in reporting, please email us at [wbctrapnetwork@gmail.com](mailto:wbctrapnetwork@gmail.com). Give your trap site name, trap number (red circle), the error made and the correct information. Only Administrators of the site can correct reporting errors.

Even if you have 0 (zero) moths in the trap for a week, it is important that information be reported.

Please note that you cannot report moth catches for a week that has not passed yet. The WBC Trap network works on a 1 week delay. This allows for trapping participants to gather and report trap counts. So, for the week of May 29 to June 4, 2017 (week 1 of trapping), any moths caught cannot be reported until after midnight on June 5, 2017.
