This document applies to the 2013 crop year and shall remain in force each subsequent year until it is cancelled, amended or replaced.

Planting deadlines for spring-seeded grains and oilseeds 2013 Production Insurance

The planting deadline is the last day that a crop can be planted and still qualify for Production Insurance coverage. Planting deadlines vary by area, depending on the available crop heat units, soil characteristics, historical claim rate experience, or other specific geographical characteristics. To qualify for Production Insurance coverage, you must plant by the deadlines listed in the table below.

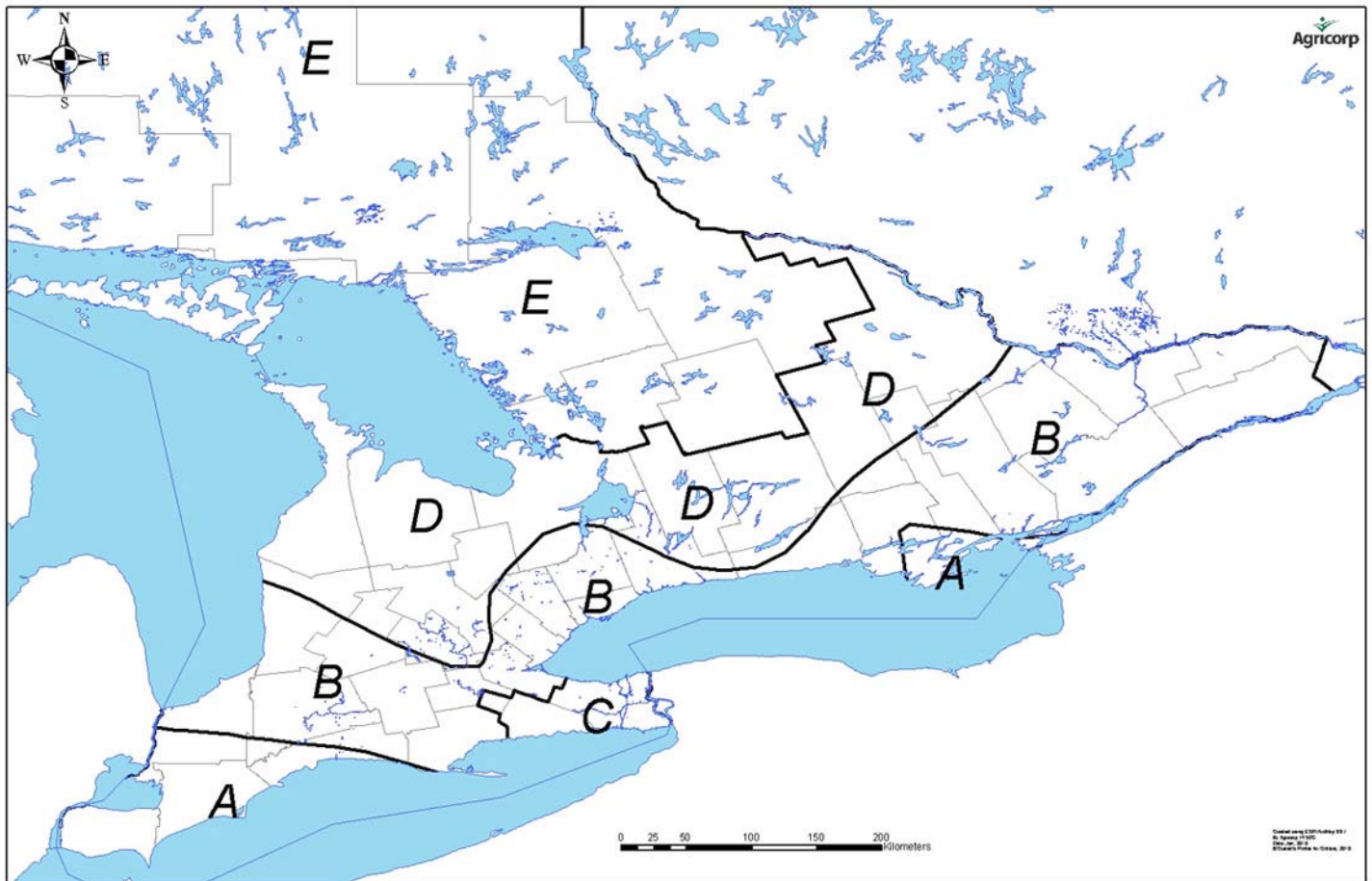
Use good farm management practices when planting

To maintain your Production Insurance coverage, you are expected to use good farm management practices at all times. For example, for early-seeded crops you must consider soil temperature and condition, weather forecast, seed quality, and seed treatments. Crops planted late in the season must use seed that is adapted for a shorter growing period (e.g., lower CHU requirement). If you use practices that contribute to a production or reseed loss, you may lose some or all of your insurance coverage.
