

## 2017 Planting deadlines Spring-seeded grains and oilseeds

The planting deadline is the last day a crop can be planted to qualify for coverage. Planting deadlines vary by area, depending on the available crop heat units (CHU), soil features, historical claim rate experience, or other specific geographical characteristics. ### Use good farm management practices when planting

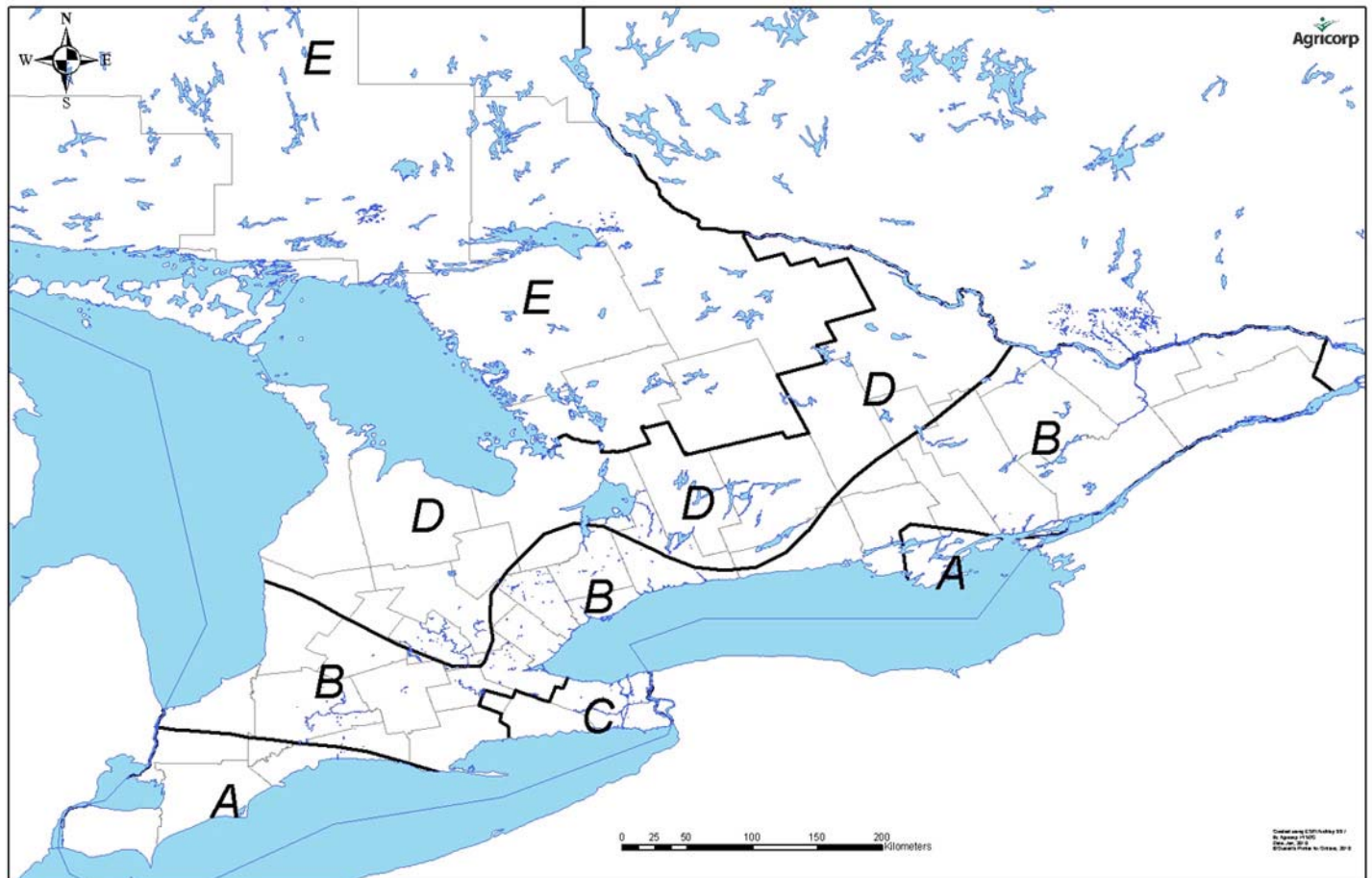
To maintain your Production Insurance coverage, you are expected to use good farm management practices at all times. Consider soil temperature and condition, weather forecast, seed quality, and seed treatments. Crops planted late in the season must use seed that is adapted for a shorter growing period. If you use practices that contribute to a production or reseed loss, you may lose some or all of your insurance coverage.

\*Production Insurance Documents (PIDs) form part of the Contract of Insurance and are used in the interpretation of the *Contract of Insurance* and the determination of claims under the *Contract of Insurance*. Except where provided otherwise, each PID shall be in force for the crop year in respect of which it is made and shall continue in force for each crop year thereafter until it is cancelled, amended or replaced. All capitalized terms used in this PID shall have the meaning given in the *Contract of Insurance*. Where there is any conflict between the provisions of a PID and the provisions of Part I of the *Contract of Insurance*, the provisions in the PID take precedence. Where there is any conflict between the provisions of a PID and the provisions of an Insuring Agreement of the Contract of Insurance, the provisions of the Insuring Agreement take precedence.

**Areas C and E are defined by municipal boundaries, as follows:**

<b>Area C</b>	Niagara and Haldimand County and Tuscarora Township
<b>Area E</b>	Northern Ontario, the districts of Algoma, Cochrane, Kenora, Manitoulin, Muskoka, Nipissing, Parry Sound, Rainy River, Sudbury, Thunder Bay, Temiskaming, and the county of Haliburton.
